# DON'T OVERLOOK SECONDARY CHINESE LISTENING COMPREHENSION 

## What are the scopes and how can you do well?

nn the O-Level Chinese examination, Listening Comprehension is a component that is part of Paper 3 and carries $10 \%$ weightage of the total marks. This component is often neglected by students, partly due to the lack of resources in the market for selfrevision as well as its low examination weightage. However, with many students facing challenges in the written components such as Composition Writing and Comprehension, scoring well in Listening Comprehension could significantly boost their overall performance.

## Tackling Listening Comprehension

After gaining a better understanding of the areas tested for Listening Comprehension, students should learn how to approach the listening task systematically to achieve optimal results.
At the beginning of the examination, students should scan through the questions and identify the keywords within each question as soon as permission is given for them to turn over the paper. While the passages are being read, students should listen carefully for the keywords in order to determine the correct answers. Even if they miss certain parts of the audio, students should not panic. The passages will be read a second time, providing an opportunity for them to check their answers.
