How does it compare with the previous syllabus?

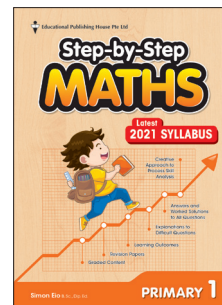


The MOE typically reviews subject syllabuses once every few years and we see a new Primary 1 Mathematics syllabus being introduced this year.

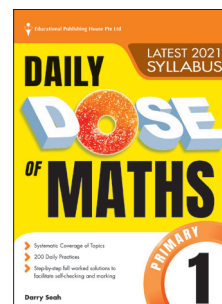
To help parents be better informed of the changes in the new Primary 1 syllabus, we present the major changes between the old and new syllabuses in a table below.

TOPIC	OLD SYLLABUS	NEW SYLLABUS
Length	Measure and compare the length of objects in units	Measure and compare the length of objects in centimetres Measure and draw line segment to the nearest centimetre
Time	Tell time to the hour/ half hour	Tell time to 5 minutes Use of 'a.m.' and 'p.m.' Use of abbreviations h and min Duration of one hour/ half hour
Shapes	Identify, name, describe and classify 2D shapes (rectangle, square, triangle, circle) Make and complete patterns with 2D shapes using size, shape, colour or orientation	Identify, name, describe and classify 2D shapes (rectangle, square, triangle, circle, half circle, quarter circle) Form different 2D figures with rectangle, square, triangle, circle, half circle, quarter circle Identify 2D shapes that make up a given figure Copy figures on dot grid or square grid

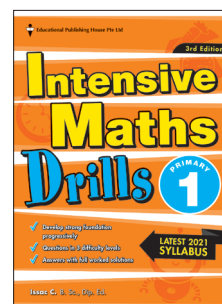
